### **Fantastic family day out at Mount Edgcumbe Country Park**

Sunday 3<sup>rd</sup> August is the date for the increasingly popular classic and American car show and Fayre at Mount Edgcumbe Country Park at Cremyll, near Millbrook, Cornwall.

This will be the show's fourteenth year and is set to be bigger and better than ever with over 200 stalls and over 600 classic and American cars. There will also be a host of other entertainment including the City of Plymouth Concert Band and the Tony Harris Dance Band as well as refreshment stands and children's games and rides.

The event runs from 11am to 5pm and entry is free to public spectators and pedestrians, car parking is £5 for cars and £2 for motor cycles. All proceeds from the event will go towards Cornwall Hospice Care and The Friends of Mount Edgcumbe Country Park, both of which are registered charities.

Cornwall Hospice Care is an independent Cornish Charity offering 24 in-patient beds across two units – St Julia's Hospice in Hayle and Mount Edgcumbe Hospice in St Austell and day patient facilities. It provides specialist palliative care, along with emotional and spiritual support to patients, their family and carers in their time of need. This highly professional and specialist service has annual running costs of £5.3 million – of which 85 pence in every pound must be met from voluntary contributions.

The Friends of Mount Edgcumbe Country Park was established to assist in the preservation of the park, for the benefit of the public, as a place of historic, botanical and natural beauty.

"Come along for a fabulous family day out and help to support these two charities," said Claire Bray, one of the organisers of the event.
